- Print as many copies of the attached form as you need.
- Type or print clearly in ink and include only one recipe per form.
- If you need more room, attach another sheet and staple it to the first with your name printed at the top.
- List all ingredients in order of use in the ingredients list and directions.
- Include container sizes; e.g., 8-oz. pkg., 15-oz. can, 1-qt. casserole
- Put directions in paragraph form, not in steps.
- Use names of ingredients, like "Combine flour and sugar," NOT "Combine first two ingredients."
- Include temperatures and cooking, chilling, baking and/or freezing times.
- Be consistent with the spelling of your name for each recipe you contribute.
- Your recipes should fit into the following categories:

Soups & Salads
Vegetables & Side Dishes

Main Dishes
Breads & Rolls
Desserts
Cookies & Candy
